  - Marketing, promotion and organization of health materials
- Serve as health resource to students at Fullerton College
- Learn about various health topics
- Network with other students, staff, and community organizations

#### **Selection & Involvement**

- Intern for at least 6 hours. Must be completed by the application deadline.
- Interviews will be held at the end of spring semester to decide who will be brought on as a paid PHE the following academic year.  
*(Interviews will be scheduled between Monday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and Thursday May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020)*
- Complete training to become certified as a Peer Health Educator
  - 12 hour training course and certification test
  - Training held 1-2 weeks prior to the start of the Fall semester
- Work between 10-20 hours weekly (paid)

#### **Benefits to Participants**

- This training provides students with a head start in functioning as a health educator, which is important in many health careers.
- Builds a student's resume for college transfer, nursing or other allied health programs.
- Lays the groundwork for participation in health education activities at 4-year colleges and universities.
